Santa Fe Ten Memorial Foundation Guidelines for Submission Indian Statue

Submissions Due: October 30, 2021

Main concept

The mission of the Santa Fe Ten Memorial Foundation is to design and build a memorial that remembers, honors and celebrates those who died, and all individuals impacted on May 18, 2018. Our vision is to inspire hope and resilience in our community by creating a thought-provoking space with a blend of architecture, artistry, and history that will create an unforgettable encounter from all who visit.

The Indian Statue represents an artistic component in the overall planned Santa Fe Ten Memorial. It will be a standalone piece than can be sculpted off site and installed independently of the permanent Memorial.

Location

The proposed location of the sculpture will be located at Santa Fe High School, 16000 Highway 6, Santa Fe, TX 77517 in the middle of the courtyard outside the theater. See pictures in Figures 1 and 2 below.

Visiting the Site

Design Elements

Mandatory design elements are summarized below:

- The statue should be culturally appropriate.
- Larger than life size would be most appropriate for the planned location.
- Consider using natural energy sources or low cost options for aesthetic lighting.
- Include area for QR code which will link to our website for further information.
- Include area for dedication text, and listing artist and donor names.
- Do not include a water element.

Suggested thematic elements are summarized below:

- Symbolism warrior spirit, Ten feathers or Ten Kindred Spirits
- Historically accurate representation of indigenous people from the area

Refrain from including the following:

- The words "Santa Fe Strong"
- Any theme or reference to religion or politics
- Any theme or reference that would be considered culturally inappropriate

Construction considerations are detailed below:

- Material selected should last decades with minimal repair
- Alternative materials or suggestions should be included in the event that the total cost of the project

- needs to be reduced
- The design should strive for minimal to moderate maintenance requirements
- Ability to withstand hurricane level winds and gulf-coast weather

Submission Requirements

Individuals or a team may submit a proposal.

Submission Requirements are listed below and should be sent by email to sftenmemorialfoundation@gmail.com by October 30, 2021 at 5:00 pm:

- Contact sheet with name(s), address, email and phone number (PDF or Word format)
- Biographical statement(s) (PDF or Word format)
- Portfolio with pictures and website links of previous work (PDF or Word format)
- Minimum of 2 references (PDF or Word format)
- Detailed budget including cost of labor and materials. If labor or materials will be donated, provide the in-kind value. (Excel format)
- Signed intellectual property release (PDF format) from each submitter which can be downloaded from www.sftenmemorial.org/the-indian-statue
- Detailed renderings of sculpture, including measurements, proposed materials, color and multiple views (front, back, side, and/or ariel). 3D or digital drawings preferred, if possible, in PDF, Word or Picture format (.jpg, .png or .gif).

Intellectual Property:

- All intellectual property related to the submission, including but not limited to the renderings, video, photography, preliminary sculptures and final statue, will be owned by the Santa Fe Ten Memorial
- A signed intellectual property agreement from each submitter is required for consideration of the proposal
- Video and pictures should be taken during the design and construction process to use for promotional purposes and to provide updates the Foundation and community on the status of the sculpture

- 12/9/2021– Final sculpture proposal selected by the Foundation

- TBD SFISD Board meeting for vote of receipt of sculpture donation
- 4/30/2022 Final sculpture should be completed and ready to install
- 5/13/2022 Final sculpture should be installed at SFHS (on or before)
- 5/18/2022 Sculpture dedication

Fees and Contracts

Sculptors will not be paid fees for design and submission of proposals. The scope of work, budget and invoicing will be finalized between the artist(s) and the Santa Fe Ten Memorial Foundation once a design has been selected. The sculpture will be presented to the Santa Fe Independent School District as a donation.

You and the Foundation may be referred to herein collectively as the "Parties."

Nothing in this Assignment Agreement shall be construed to create any relationship of employer and employee, agent and principal, partners, or joint venture partners between You and the Foundation.
